
Suggested Colour Card

- Custom made colours can be dyed, for this product the reproduction of the colour is influenced by the composition of the yarn.



 - Alternatively, dry clean only with the appropriate solvents.

Important Notes

- Alpaca contains black hair, which becomes noticeable in **white and light shades.**
 - These should be considered as a characteristic of Alpaca and Alpaca Blended yarns.
 - We use splicers in most of our yarns.
 - The average number of knots per kilo is about 4/5.
 - All our dye stuffs used are heavy metal free, **AZO-Free and comply with the REACH and OEKO-TEX STANDARDS.**
